Complete this form to be considered for the federal Teacher Education Assistance for College and Higher Education (TEACH) Grant Program. The TEACH Grant provides up to \$4,000 per year (\$16,000 total for 4-year undergraduate program, and \$8,000 per year of which may be used at HCC) to students who commit to:

- Teaching full-time in high-need subject areas.
- For at least four out of the eight years, teaching at a school serving low-income families.

If the commitment is not fulfilled, the grant is permanently converted to a loan to be repaid by the recipient. The loan is a Federal Direct Unsubsidized Loan with interest calculated from the time of the grant disbursement.

- I will teach for four years at a school serving low-income students.

If I fail to meet all of the conditions of the award or, if the conditions are not documented as required, I understand that the award will permanently convert to a Ford Federal Direct Unsubsidized Loan and that I will be responsible to repay this loan with interest calculated from the disbursement date of the grant. I understand that once a TEACH Grant is converted to a loan, it cannot be converted back to grant.
